

# September Interactive Meeting

"The Camera Records – The Artist Creates"

Our second monthly meeting is bearing fruit.

Thanks to a suggestion by a new member last year, we decided to add the meeting to discuss items of interest, to explore our craft and to use it as a platform to spend time on the neglected "Set subject".

On September 11, we were treated to two unusual aspects. The first, led by Anne Hrabar, was a review and discussion of changes to images suggested by our August external judge Jaques Sellschop and executed by him to illustrate his points.

While "tampering" with images is not "the done thing" for judges, this really stimulated discussion among the record number of attendees with some liking the suggested changes and others defending their position fairly vigorously. Personally, I found the experience enriching and thought provoking. I have no doubt that those affected will carefully consider any future images of similar scenes in future.

In my view this was far more useful than dry comments repeated without any opportunity to see what the judge is getting at.

This was followed by a marvelous, carefully crafted presentation by Luana titled "The Camera Records – The Artist Creates".

Luana had all of us enthralled throughout the presentation by showing us different, and artistic, takes on the genres that we are all so familiar with. Real motion in sport, such different street, nature and landscape images as well as her own rendition of a Jackson Pollock style abstract.

She showed images by Pep Ventosa (a tree photographed from all sides and combined in camera), Long exposure landscapes, by Shona Perkins, flower photography using lens baby lenses and many others.

Probably the most important lessons to be learnt were the importance of -

- Intent
- The story
- Emotion
- Subjectivity, and
- Having a basic concept of Art

Luana showed the difference between the rules-bound, non-manipulated, constrained images usually submitted to clubs and salons and the unconstrained creations of an artist, using a camera as a tool.

The presentation was recorded and without question will prove to be one of our most valuable resources for future reference.

Thanks to our presenters and to members for their support.

The next meeting, on October 9, will deal with the set subject which is "Triptych"
